



SEMI-RETIRED PRACTITIONER

PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

The purpose of the policy is to recognize the contribution by the senior retired semi-members of the profession who have contributed to the delivery of health care in Zimbabwe so that they remain on the Register whilst paying a minimal fee to cover administrative Costs.

MEMBERS AFFECTED BY THIS POLICY

Medical and Dental practitioners who have attained the age of 70 years or more and wish to remain on the Register and undertake minimal private practice.

POLICY

All practitioners who have attained the age of 70 years or over and have practiced in Zimbabwe for at least 45 years may pay 50 % of the prevailing fees to retain their names on the Honorary Register.

PROCEDURE FOR ONE TO BE PLACED ON THE HONORARY REGISTER

The practitioner must have attained the age of 70 years.
The practitioner must not be in charge of a private hospital.
The practitioner must have worked in Zimbabwe for at least 45 years. The practitioner must be semi - retired.
The practitioner must not be operating a registered private practice.
The practitioner must comply with CPD requirements. The practitioner may hold an administrative post.

OBJECTIVE OF THE POLICY

The objective of the policy is to enable practitioners who are semi retired to afford the retention fee and continue to undertake limited Practice.
